## **Consumer Disclosures**

### **Graduation Rates for 2015**

Of the 33 students in the **BARBER/STYLIST 1800 CLOCK HOUR PROGRAM** and of the 1 student in the **BARBER/STYLIST for LICENSED COSMETOLOGIST 1000 CLOCK HOUR PROGRAM** who were scheduled to graduate, 55.88%\*(19 students total) graduated within 150% of the permitted completion time.

### **Licensure and Placement Rates for 2015**

The licensure rate was 100%\* of those students who completed and sat for the Ohio State Barber Board Licensure Exam. Of those who completed, the official placement rate was 78.95%.\*

Note: Graduates who have not taken the licensure exam are included in the placement rate (there was 1 in 2015)

### **Graduation Rates for 2014**

Of the 42 students in the **BARBER/STYLIST 1800 CLOCK HOUR PROGRAM** and of the 1 student in the **BARBER/STYLIST for LICENSED COSMETOLOGIST 1000 CLOCK HOUR PROGRAM** who were scheduled to graduate, 65.12%\*(28 students total) graduated within 150% of the permitted completion time.

### **Licensure and Placement Rates for 2014**

The licensure rate was 96.30%\* of those students who completed and sat for the Ohio State Barber Board Licensure Exam. Of those who completed, the official placement rate was 85.71%.\*

Note: Graduates who have not taken the licensure exam are included in the placement rate (there was 1 in 2014)
