Graduation Rates for 2017

Of the 26 students in the BARBER/STYLIST 1800 CLOCK HOUR PROGRAM and of the 1 student in the BARBER/STYLIST for LICENSED COSMETOLOGIST 1000 CLOCK HOUR PROGRAM who were scheduled to graduate, 51.85%*(14 students total) graduated within 150% of the permitted completion time.

Licensure and Placement Rates for 2017

The licensure rate was 100%* of those students who completed and sat for the Ohio State Barber Board (in 2018 became the Ohio State Cosmetology and Barber Board) Licensure Exam. Of those who completed, the official placement rate was 78.57%.*

Note: Graduates who have not taken the licensure exam are included in the placement rate (there were 2 in 2017)

Graduation Rates for 2016

Of the 32 students in the BARBER/STYLIST 1800 CLOCK HOUR PROGRAM and of the 2 students in the BARBER/STYLIST for LICENSED COSMETOLOGIST 1000 CLOCK HOUR PROGRAM who were scheduled to graduate, 41.18%*(14 students total) graduated within 150% of the permitted completion time.

Licensure and Placement Rates for 2016

The licensure rate was 100%* of those students who completed and sat for the Ohio State Barber Board (in 2018 became the Ohio State Cosmetology and Barber Board) Licensure Exam. Of those who completed, the official placement rate was 64.29%.*

Note: Graduates who have not taken the licensure exam are included in the placement rate (there was 4 in 2016)
